I would like to take this opportunity to wish you and your families a Happy New Year as we begin 2024. The start of the year is an opportunity to look back over the last few months while

we also gaze forward with hope to the new that is before us. I invite you to do this with me here at St. Kevin's parish. Included in this week's bulletin is the Fiscal Statement for St. Kevin Church, from September 2022 to August 2023. Please take a moment to study the Income and Expenses of running the parish. You will notice, our current expenses are above what we bring in through weekly donations, rentals, parish programs and fundraising. Without the extraordinary revenue of generous members of the parish and a bequest, we would have operated at a loss. These extra revenues made it possible to replace the boiler in the school building and address some other repairs that were needed in the convent. As we look at the current fiscal year, the parish is running in the black and with your generous support, I am sure we will continue to do so. However, we still have some major expenses to pay. These include our insurance bill, the Diocesan Assessment, and the ordinary upkeep of the parish plant.

As you plan your stewardship to St. Kevin's this coming year, I ask that you consider three ways to make a lasting difference on the parish. First, if you have not yet signed up for online giving, I encourage you to do so today through our website at: StKevinFlushing.org. Online giving allows you to setup automatic weekly offerings to St. Kevin's. Doing so helps us to better budget the finances of the parish. Second, is to consider making a legacy donation to St. Kevin's by including the parish in your will and estate planning. Third, is to investigate matching charitable contributions that may be available thru your place of employment or to make a charitable gift to St. Kevin's from an investment portfolio.

### From the Music Director

For Auld Lang Syne

Most people throughout the English-speaking world either sing this song or hear it every New Year's Eve. Yet few of us know what these three words are all about. Translated literally, the title means "old long since," loosely translated it's "For (the sake of) old times." The song begins by posing two rhetorical questions as to whether it is right that old times be forgotten; since by remembering the past, we reaffirm the importance of our future, and those important to us.

Robert Burns, the national poet of Scotland, "restored" the text around 1788 from fragments of old ballads dating as far back as 15<sup>th</sup> century Scotland and set it to a traditional folk song. However, his lyrics were paired with the more famous melody we sing today by George Thompson in 1799.

Singing the song on New Year's Eve very quickly became a Scots custom that soon spread to other parts of the British Isles. And as people immigrated to the new world, they brought the song with them. Beginning in 1929, just two months after the stock market crash and beginning of the Great Depression, Canadian band leader Guy Lombardo is credited for cementing its popularity as an expression of hope though his annual New Year's Eve broadcasts on radio and later, television.




