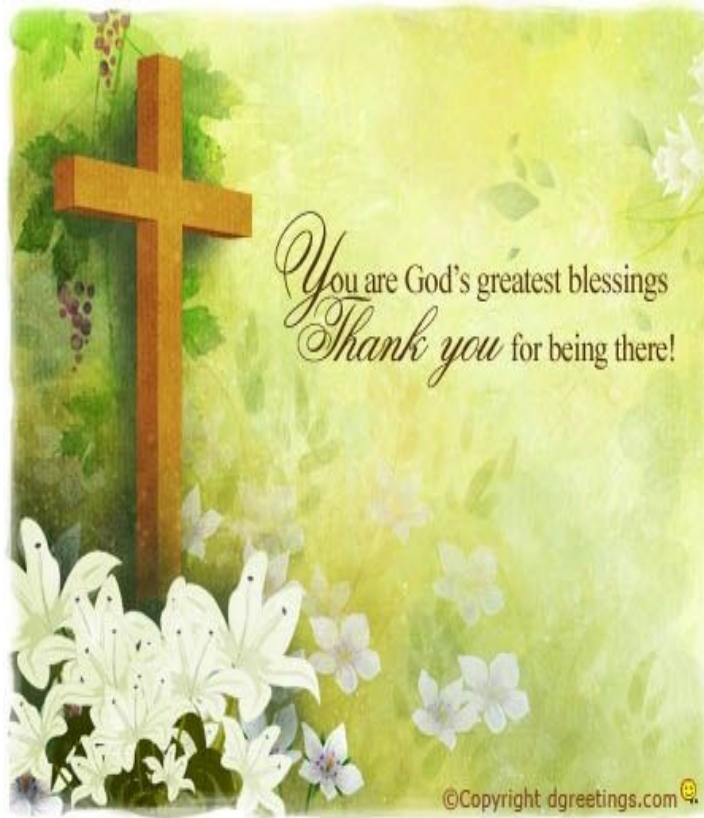

From the Music Director

The Jesus Song

Tom Booth began composing music four decades ago at the University of Arizona, where he majored in music history and minored in religious studies. He shared his inspiration for “The Jesus Song”: “I was asked by the Franciscan Renewal Center in Scottsdale to lead a retreat. Asking myself, ‘What song could we pray to focus on the mercy of God and to try to live out the good news of God with us?’ I wanted something simple and direct. I had been praying ‘The Jesus Prayer’ for a few years (also known as the Eastern or Orthodox ‘Prayer of the Heart’): ‘Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on me, a sinner.’ As I set this simple prayer to music, I sensed it needed another section. I began to sing a different vocal line, ‘Jesus, I trust in you!’ This I recognized as a prayer from the Divine Mercy devotion. Uh oh! I was combining two devotions and two messages... or was I? ‘The Jesus Prayer’ puts us at the feet of Jesus, and Divine Mercy asks us to trust God in all things. Praying this song with others has been very rewarding.”



I love that he doesn't say “singing this song with others” but “praying this song with others.” If you didn't get a chance to pray it along with us at Mass this weekend, google it!

Stewardship Education and Reflections on the Weekly Mass Readings

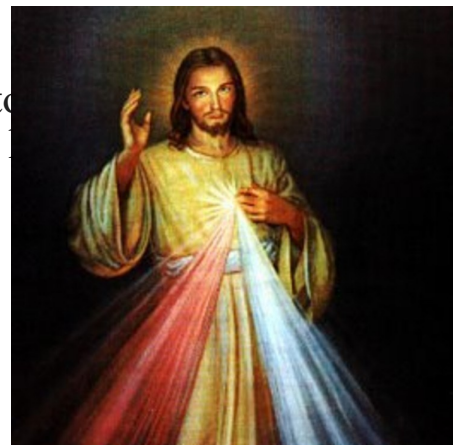
On this second Sunday of Easter, we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. We celebrate this feast today since God's mercy was shared with us through the resurrection of Jesus. To put it simply, today, we are celebrating Jesus' merciful love for us and how we can partake in it.

No matter where we are on our journey as a disciple of Christ, we are all in need of God's merciful love. There are countless times throughout our day when we miss the mark. For instance, we might fail to respond in kind to our spouse or kids, fall into gossip in our workday, or even forget to think positively of others. These shortcomings call us to humble ourselves and receive the unwavering mercy of God.

Jesus is Mercy itself. He was born into time to save us from sin. And to ensure His Mercy was always available to us, He gave us the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In our Gospel, Jesus encounters the apostles after the resurrection and says, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." Jesus gave us the gift of this sacrament because He wants to help us reach eternal life. He knows we cannot do it without His merciful love, and a resolve to do better and to follow Him more faithfully.

Today, may we recall the precious gift God has given to us: Mercy itself. May we never forget that, with a contrite heart and a resolve to do better, God is always willing to forgive.

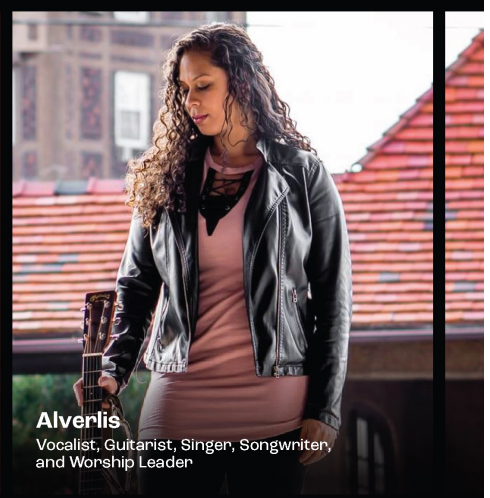

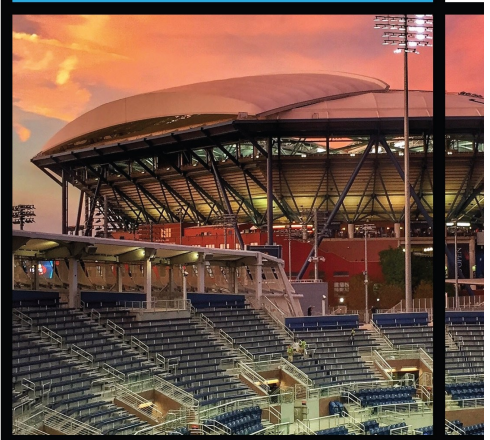

Registration for September 2024

The St. Kevin Office of Religious Education provides a comprehensive faith formation program for children in grades 1-8 that do not attend a Catholic School.

Registration for September, 2024 Religious Education classes is ongoing thru September. Families who are already in our program will receive notification via email. Any families new to the program can visit our parish website for the on-line registration form at: <https://stkevinflushing.org/faith-formation/registration>. All new children or families please include in your email your child's baptismal certificate plus vaccination record, which are needed for registration. Our classes will be as follows:

Classes will be remote two Sunday's a month and in school two Sunday's. Sunday Mass attendance is required for all families in our program. Families are asked to attend the 9:00 AM mass with their children. Then the children will go to the school for instruction from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Parents are invited to the Parish Hall for an Adult session while your children are in class. Remote classes will be scheduled on Sunday morning. If you are not able the 9:00 AM Mass, please choose another mass to fulfill your Sunday Obligation.

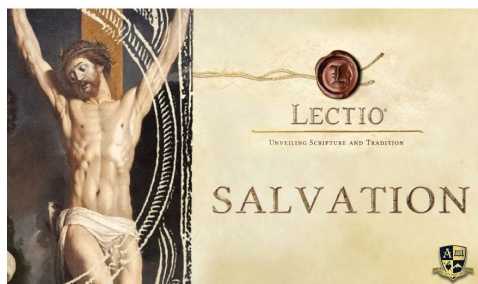
