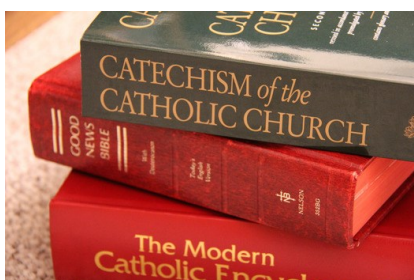


## From the Music Director

### *Liturgical Guidelines from the new Directory of Catechesis*

The liturgical magazine *GIA Quarterly* explains: “the new *Directory for Catechesis* considers both the opportunities and the challenges the Church faces in an ever more global and secular society. Building upon the Second Vatican Council, the Catechism of the Catholic Church, and the ongoing work of the new evangelization, it gives several guidelines for liturgy:

- 1) Do parishioners see and welcome strangers as we gather for liturgy before Mass begins?
- 2) Do we sing hymns and Mass parts with a sense of freedom and joy?
- 3) Is the Eucharistic Prayer a joyful sacrifice of praise? Are the acclamations sung by the entire baptismal priesthood? (That’s us!)
- 4) Is the communion procession a joyful expression of the unity of the People of God? (Or do we try to make it a time of personal devotion? We shouldn’t!)
- 5) Is the final hymn a joyful call to the freedom of God’s saving love?



As we continue our journey of encounter with the mystery of Jesus Christ, doing these things will shape a faith community into being not only well-informed but deeply transformed by the richness of the liturgical experience.

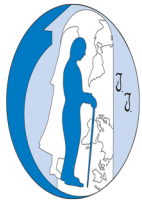

## Registration for September 2024

The St. Kevin Office of Religious Education provides a comprehensive faith formation program for children in grades 1-8 that do not attend a Catholic School.

Registration for September, 2024 Religious Education classes is ongoing thru September. Families who are already in our program will receive notification via email. Any families new to the program can visit our parish website for the on-line registration form at: <https://stkevinflushing.org/faith-formation/registration>. All new children or families please include in your email your child's baptismal certificate plus vaccination record, which are needed for registration. Our classes will be as follows:

**Classes will be remote two Sunday's a month and in school two Sunday's. Sunday Mass attendance is required for all families in our program. Families are asked to attend the 9:00 AM mass with their children. Then the children will go to the school for instruction from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Parents are invited to the Parish Hall for an Adult session while your children are in class. Remote classes will be scheduled on Sunday morning. If you are not able the 9:00 AM Mass, please choose another mass to fulfill your Sunday Obligation.**
