### From the Music Director

*Celebrate Cinco de Mayo with authentic Mexican Music!*

*Son*, meaning sound in Spanish, is the roots from which the tree of Mexican folk music blossoms. It mixes native influences with the sounds of Africa and Spain. Typically, it includes just guitar, violin, a large acoustic bass guitar known as a *guitarron*, and a small drum. Ritchie Valens’ “La Bamba” is an adaptation of a traditional *son* song.

*Ranchera*, meaning “from the ranch,” is the country style that evolved from *son* around the turn of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. *Norteno* comes from the northern part of Mexico, and incorporates sounds from German, Bohemian, Moravian, and Czech cultures. It often includes accordion and tuba.

*Mariachi*, which grew out of *son* in the 19<sup>th</sup> century, is the most popular form of Mexican music. The costumes are called *traje de charro* and are distinguished by their tight fit and extreme ornamentation. The sound of mariachi is the fullest of these styles, including guitars, guitarrons, violins, drums, brass, and vocals. So enjoy some authentic Mexican music with your guacamole and margaritas!

## Registration for September 2024

The St. Kevin Office of Religious Education provides a comprehensive faith formation program for children in grades 1-8 that do not attend a Catholic School.

Registration for September, 2024 Religious Education classes is ongoing thru September. Families who are already in our program will receive notification via email. Any families new to the program can visit our parish website for the on-line registration form at: <https://stkevinflushing.org/faith-formation/registration>. All new children or families please include in your email your child's baptismal certificate plus vaccination record, which are needed for registration. Our classes will be as follows:

**Classes will be remote two Sunday's a month and in school two Sunday's. Sunday Mass attendance is required for all families in our program. Families are asked to attend the 9:00 AM mass with their children. Then the children will go to the school for instruction from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Parents are invited to the Parish Hall for an Adult session while your children are in class. Remote classes will be scheduled on Sunday morning. If you are not able the 9:00 AM Mass, please choose another mass to fulfill your Sunday Obligation.**

Stewardship Education and Reflections on the Weekly Mass Readings



Our readings today call us to love as Christ loves.

In our Gospel, Jesus says, “Love one another as I have loved you.” The ways Jesus has loved us and continues to love us are endless.

We are called to imitate this love. And He tells us the greatest way to do this when He said, “No one has greater love than this, to lay down one’s life for one’s friends.”

It is difficult to live that out in our humanity. Yet, it is made much easier when we faithfully love Christ. The fact of the matter is, as our love for Christ increases, so too does our capacity to love others.

There are countless moments when we can do just that — for instance, waking up Saturday morning to attend daily Mass instead of sleeping in, or talking to God in the car on the way to work instead of listening to music. These are simple ways to express our love for the Lord by laying down our lives for Him.

The more we find ways to love the Lord, the more we will find it easier to put aside our selfishness and serve others.

Christ’s command to love others may seem daunting. Yet, Christ would never ask something of us that we cannot live out. All we need to do is take baby steps. Ask yourself, "How can I better love Jesus right now?" for it is in loving Christ that we will better love others, and it is in loving others that we love Christ Himself.


## Saint John Paul II | Lukas Storyteller
